# Our Events



## National Conference

The National Conference is the major event in The Housing Forum's busy year and is highly rated by our audience of over 300 leading sector figures. Delegates include housing associations and local councils, contractors/developers, suppliers and manufacturers, consultancies and representatives from government departments and public bodies including Government departments and Homes England. Our panels of speakers provide deep sector knowledge and insights, the place where we develop solutions in partnership to address the profound current challenges in supply, safety and regulation.

## Housing Partnership Summits

Housing Partnership Summits are a series of collaborative events aimed at addressing critical housing challenges across the UK through regional focus and expert partnerships. These half-day summits bring together housing providers, councils, developers, sustainability experts, and investors to explore strategies for delivering quality homes, tackling environmental challenges, and responding to the unique needs of different regions - and will include a site tour. Delegates have the opportunity to network with a diverse mix of housing professionals— encouraging cross-sector partnerships and collaboration, which is essential in addressing complex issues like housing shortages, sustainable development, and policy implementation.

## Existing Stock Forums

Existing Stock Forums (ESFs) focus on key asset management challenges, offering a venue for experts across the sector to discuss and improve practices in housing stock reinvestment, building safety, sustainability, and retrofitting for energy efficiency. ESFs are relevant for asset managers, contractors, and public officials seeking to adapt to evolving standards and climate goals, as well as other housing and construction professionals who are looking to deepen their understanding of the sector. These events can be online or in-person, and each one provides detailed discussions, case studies, and Q&A sessions, equipping housing sector professionals with the knowledge to navigate complex regulatory landscapes while also advancing toward net-zero housing goals.

## Spring & Autumn Online Conferences

The Housing Forum is a national network of organisations involved in the commissioning, design and building of affordable homes and Councils play an important part in the network. Through our Councils Network we provide a positive contribution to knowledge sharing and partnership working at both the strategic and practitioner level. The Spring and Autumn Online Conferences serve as key platforms for local authorities and housing sector professionals to discuss pressing issues and innovative approaches to housing and development. The events are designed to bring together council representatives, housing associations, developers, and consultants to explore emerging challenges, regulatory updates, and successful case studies in the housing sector.

## Decarbonisation & Sustainability Forums

Decarbonisation and Sustainability Forums focus on critical issues in the housing sector related to reducing carbon emissions, enhancing sustainability, and aligning with the UK's climate goals. They can be either online or in-person, and serve as a platform for industry experts to discuss decarbonisation and sustainability initiatives, both for new construction and for retrofitting existing buildings. Topics include the Future Homes Standard, solar and renewable energy projects, biodiversity integration, and climate risk resilience in housing development.

## Learning at Lunchtime Webinars

These webinars are 45-minute, member-focused sessions that tackle specific industry topics, offering a deep dive into essential subjects, such as design codes, workforce diversity, regulations compliance, and sustainability. Topics are often driven by current housing sector challenges and member interest, making these sessions relevant and highly practical. These webinars support ongoing professional development and provide a platform for members to share and gain knowledge on critical issues affecting the housing and construction sector.

## CEO Roundtables

CEO Roundtables are exclusive, invitation-only events that convene high-level executives and decision-makers in housing, construction, and development to tackle sector challenges from a strategic and policy-oriented viewpoint. They are specifically designed for senior leaders, providing a unique setting where discussions are held under Chatham House rules to ensure candid dialogue. The discussions lead to the publication of detailed insights and practical takeaways that support executives and their teams in addressing complex issues. The roundtables are highly valuable for networking and sharing knowledge with peers who face similar challenges across the sector.
